

Since 1986 Compaid has provided support to disabled people in and around Kent, ensuring they can live their lives to the full.

Today, nearly 2,000 disabled and frail elderly people access our digital skills training and accessible transport services every year, to help them overcome barriers of digital, social and economic exclusion.

From the Medway towns to Margate, from Edenbridge to Hastings, our committed team of staff and volunteers work every day alongside disabled and other vulnerable people.



Our services are accessible to those with physical or learning disabilities, as well as people with mobility issues or recovering from an accident or stroke.

Digital skills training

Computer skills training is delivered both from our dedicated training centre in Paddock Wood and through outreach into local communities.

Clients discover the many different activities that computers offer. This ranges from use of social media and internet shopping, to word processing, spreadsheets and digital design.



Our training aims to help disabled adults to take greater control of their lives, pursuing personal interests and accessing other services. Many clients have moved on to volunteering and paid employment.

Accessible transport

With a fleet of over 20 wheelchair accessible minibuses and smaller adapted vehicles, we can provide for any transport need.

Journeys vary from hospital and clinic visits to larger outings to the coast and other local attractions, as well as Kent Karrier journeys in seven districts within Kent. Compaid is proud to hold the



Community Transport Association's Quality Mark, one of only a handful of organisations in the UK to gain this distinction.

Volunteering

We rely on regular volunteers to help deliver our services.

Some people choose to support our clients to learn or relearn computer skills by becoming Volunteer Trainers at our centre or in the community. Others help out as Volunteer Drivers particularly assisting disabled and elderly people to manage their weekly shopping.



Fundraising
